Harbor Planning and Research Director Task List (9234)

- Plans, develops, and maintains long-range plans and programs for Harbor Department land and water use, and development of commercial enterprises.
- 2. Coordinates long-range strategic planning with short term engineering and environmental plans.
- 3. Conducts research in connection with the above plans and programs.
- 4. Determines the need for, and feasibility of using outside consultants and monitors their contracts.
- 5. Evaluates reports of findings and conclusions made by consultants and recommends appropriate implementation.
- 6. Conducts follow-up investigations to see that recommendations are being implemented.
- 7. Analyzes and determines market potentials in future waterborne cargo flows by commodity groups, origin, destination points, type of movement, and types of marine transport used.
- 8. Undertakes cargo forecast projection and determines appropriate Port land and facility requirements.
- 9. Compares and analyzes facilities available at other ports to determine potential needs for similar or different facilities at Port of Los Angeles.
- 10. Confers with officials of other ports to coordinate inter-port planning.
- 11. Represents the Department at committee meetings, in dealing with other City departments, and governmental agencies and at outside meetings, conferences, and conventions.
- 12. Supervises the Planning staff in performing studies and preparing recommendations to Harbor Management.
- 13. Applies Equal Employment Opportunity policies and principles such as; listens to employee grievances and disputes to identify a fair solution based on facts; counsels employees regarding problems such as rule infractions or inappropriate conduct; and/or disciplines employees following departmental progressive disciplinary procedures in order to perform personnel policy functions.

- 14. Ensures Port development activities are consistent with applicable comprehensive plans including the Port Master Plan.
- 15. Develops plans and programs and makes policy recommendations for site selection for hazardous port facilities.
- 16. Analyzes the socioeconomic impact of port projects and operations using resources such as Implan and RIMS II.
- 17. Determines need for and requests issuance of coastal development permits.
- 18. Develops and implements economic development strategy of the Port, including commercial development and workforce development activities.
- 19. Assesses the competitive position of the Port and potential threats from development plans of competing ports by analyzing market data.
- 20. Assists in the development of department performance metrics and makes recommendations for strategic plans based on those metrics.
